

#### TABLE 17.1 **DECISION-MAKING OPTIONS BEST SUITED SITUATIONS** METHOD When the pros and cons are fairly straightforward and there are few unanswered Ben's Process questions Weighting When making complex judgments or the pros and cons are of varying importance Formula When there are many interacting elements and unanswered questions Informed Intuition When there are more unanswered questions than pros/cons or where there is a Robust Dialoque complex set of alternatives requiring further input
